WC Insurer's Obligation to Furnish Loss Run History

A workers' compensation insurer shall, within thirty (30) days after receipt of a written request from an insured or the insured's designee, furnish to that insured or insured's designee a copy of the insured's prior three (3) year loss run history for workers' compensation insurance, or complete loss run history with such insurer if the history is less than three (3) years. If the insurer fails to furnish the requested information within the time allowed in this section, such failure shall be a violation under the Unfair Competition and Deceptive Acts, compiled in chapter 8, part 1 of this title, and the requestor may seek enforcement and any remedies allowed pursuant to such chapter.
